<p>POSITION SUMMARY</p>	<p>Roe Environmental Inc. is seeking experienced commercial boat operators with Small Vessel Operating Proficiency (SVOP) certification, or higher class certification under the Canada Shipping Act, to aid in delivery of a Marine Mammal Monitoring Program for construction of a marine terminal at Woodfibre, on Howe Sound, near Squamish BC. The terminal is part of the Woodfibre LNG Project.</p> <p>Boat operators will be responsible for safe operation of boats to provide access for Marine Mammal Observers and environmental technicians to conduct visual observations for marine mammals, deploy sensitive monitoring equipment, and conduct water quality monitoring.</p> <p>Boats provided by Roe, will be less than 9m (27') length, appropriate to local weather/sea conditions, and rigged for safe operation.</p> <p>Position to require shift work (e.g. 10 days on – 4 days off; 7 days on – 7 days off, etc.). Normal working days are likely to be up to 10-12 hours.</p>
